

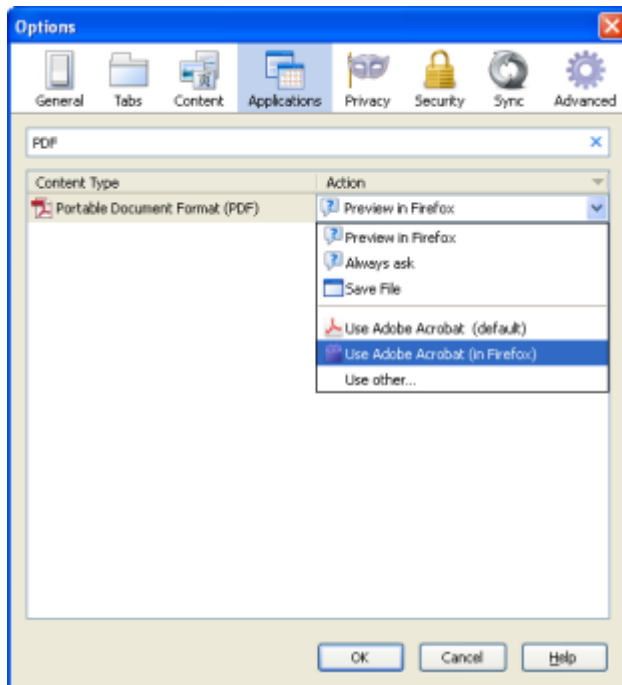
To use XFA-based PDF forms on Firefox, perform the following steps to configure Firefox to open PDFs using Adobe Reader or Adobe Acrobat.

Note:

Ensure that you have Adobe Reader or Adobe Acrobat installed on your machine.

Configure Firefox

1. In Firefox, choose **Tools > Options**.
2. In the Options dialog, click **Applications**.
3. In the Applications tab, type PDF in the search field.
4. For Portable Document Format (PDF) content type in the search result, select **Use Adobe Acrobat (in Firefox)** from the Action drop-down list.

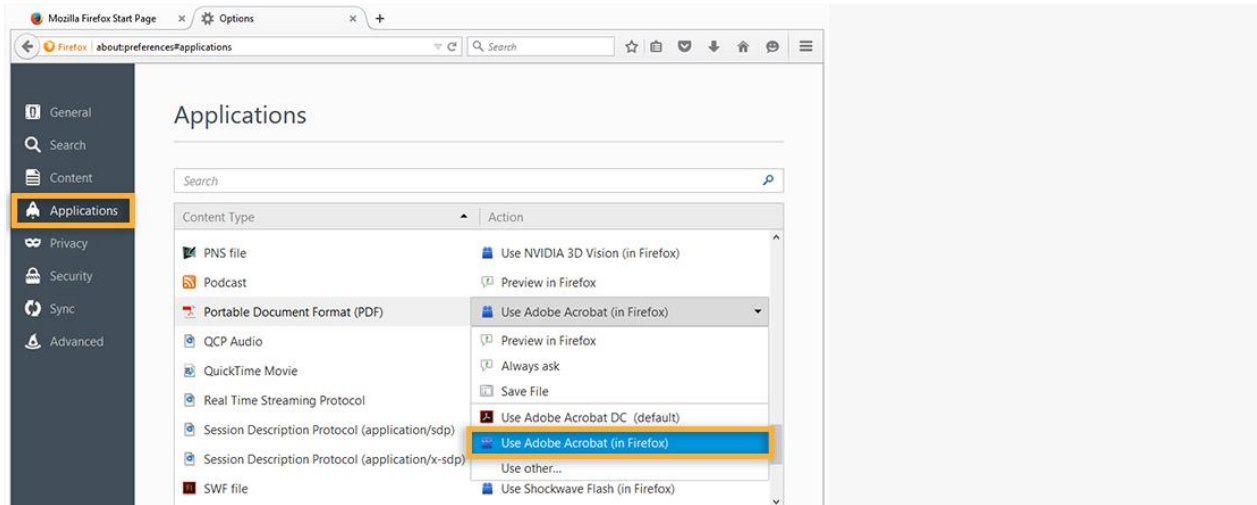


5. Click **OK**.
6. Restart Firefox.

Firefox on Windows

1. Choose **Firefox > Options > Applications**.
2. In the Content Type area, scroll to Portable Document Format (PDF).

3. Click the **Action** column next to Portable Document Format (PDF), and then select an application to open the PDF. For example, to use the Acrobat plug-in within the browser, choose **Use Adobe Acrobat (in Firefox)**.



Firefox on Mac OS

1. Select Firefox.
2. Choose Preferences > Applications.
3. Select **Portable Document Format (PDF)** from the Content Type Column.
4. Click the Action column next to Portable Document Format (PDF), and then select **Use Adobe Acrobat NPAPI Plug-in**.
